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We'd love to share with you some examples of various types of repair work with 'Before and After' images taken.

A typical Single Ended Hip Skid with a Tufnol® Handle. We also receive many Double Ended Hip Skids in for repair needing re-insulating, both versions are available to buy as new replacements.









One of the most common instruments we receive in for repair. This is a small osteotome. Osteotomes, chisels and gouges are high on the list of most common repairs due to the nature of their use.



Before

Working end of osteotome blunted and misshapen. Instrument has impact damage on the blade and may have been mis-used as a lever. There is also water staining ('marbling') caused during reprocessing.



Before

Cracked and peeled Nylon coating which occurs over time through repeated sterile processing due to the steel core heating (expanding) and cooling (contracting).



After

Nylon coating fully replaced following the correct preparation procedure which includes removing the old coating, grit blasting and priming the surface for maximum adhesion and longevity of new Nylon coating.

- All repairs are carried out following initial risk assessment.
- 'Before and After' images are of the same instrument and are of actual repairs received from our customers.
- All repair work is carried out in our Sheffield based facility 'in-house' by our own engineers.
